PERCEPTION ≠ REALITY

Dax is an awarded music producer, audio engineer, Winston Churchill fellow, writer, designer and sculptor. Dax established Puzzle Factory Sound Studio in 2001. His first sculpture 'What Holds You Back?' was exhibited at Art, Not Apart 2014 and permanently homed at NewActon in October.

Perception ≠ Reality allows participants to experience a rapid (but temporary) distortion of *their* "reality". Dax seeks to challenge the philosophical principals of Absolutism and reinforce the principals of Relativism which state that no belief can be said to have absolute truth, having value only within a certain context or frame of reference. In a nutshell, perception is not necessarily equal to reality.

What is it you ask?

Wearing a specially constructed headset, with mirrors that distort your field of vision and divert it to the sides, you will experience a reality-bending maze walk to explore observation and perceptual adaptation.
